For the Shabbos Table

In recounting the gifts of the Chanukas Hamizbaech, the Torah details each of the Nesiim's Korbanos, despite their Korbonos all being identical! Why would the Torah expend so many seemingly repetitive words?

The Darkei Mussar explains that human nature is such that we become less excited with repetition. One may think that a parent of many children would have less love for each individual child, compared to a parent with fewer children. However, we know that a parents love for their child remains consistent, no matter how many children they may have. So too, whether 10 people are Davening in a Shul or 100 people,
